VIA Park & Ride Service

Park & Ride Locations

- A RANDOLPH PARK & RIDE**
(IH-35 & Randolph Blvd.) – 287 parking spaces
- B BLOSSOM ATHLETIC CENTER**
(12002 Jones Maltsberger Road) – 1000 parking spaces
- C CROSSROADS PARK & RIDE**
(NW Loop 410 & IH 10-W, east of mall) – 550 parking spaces
- D MADLA TRANSIT CENTER**
(IH-35 South & Zarzamora)– 135 parking spaces



Service Schedule

Bus service and token purchase from the Park & Ride locations to the Alamodome will start 3 hours prior to kick off. Return service will be available every 30 minutes throughout the game and will run for 45 minutes after the conclusion of the game.

Park & Ride Fares

Tokens will be sold at the Park & Ride locations.

Full Fare \$2.50 each way
Half Fare \$1.25 each way

A discount fare of \$1.25 each way (\$2.50 roundtrip) is available for children ages 5-11 as well as senior citizens 62 years and older, Medicare recipients, persons with disabilities, and students with a valid VIA ID. VIAtrans customers ride free. If the VIAtrans customer is accompanied by one companion and/or one authorized personal care attendant, all may ride special event service free of charge. Children ages 4 and under are also free when they are accompanied by an adult. VIA's monthly Big Passes and EZ Riders are not valid for special event service.



VIAtrans service to the Showdown will be available. Registered VIAtrans passengers may make reservations for service by calling 362-5050. The usual VIAtrans reservation policies and fares apply.

10 minute frequency

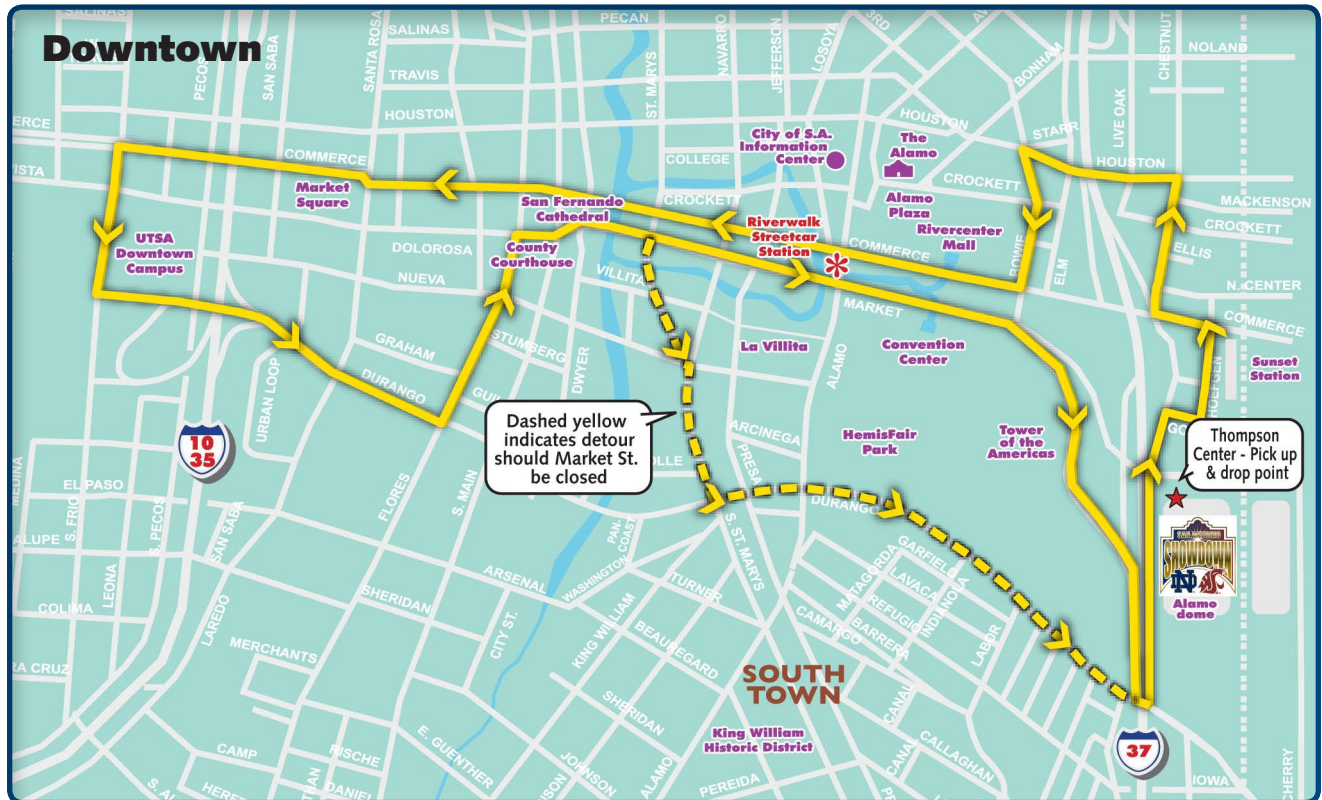
Park & Ride Hours

Yellow Route Streetcar Service



VIA has four streetcar routes carrying visitors and locals throughout the downtown area. The yellow streetcar route (shown above) goes through the center of town and also services the Alamodome. Football fans can park anywhere along the yellow route and then hop on the streetcar at one of many streetcar stops. Streetcars come by each stop about every 10 minutes.
