Recap: Oregon's 30-7 win in the 2013 Valero Alamo Bowl spoiled Mack Brown's last game in a 16 year run as Head Coach of the Longhorns. Mark Helfrich had 11 wins in his first season as the Ducks head coach, made him the winningest Oregon first-year head coach in program history. Helfrich's predecessor Chip Kelly won 10 games in his first year as Oregon head coach in 2009.

This was the Ducks fifth 11+ win season in the school's history. Oregon quarterback Marcus Mariota broke the Valero Alamo Bowl record for rushing yards by a quarterback with 133 yards, topping Eric Crouch's 118 yards against Northwestern in 2000.

In the game, Oregon senior receiver Josh Huff broke the Oregon single-season record for receiving yards with 104 yards. Huff finished the season with 1,140 yards. He also hauled in his 12th career touchdown in the second quarter, tying the Oregon career record for receiving touchdowns.

The standing room only crowd of 65,918 was the second highest attendance in Valero Alamo Bowl history and the game's third straight sellout. With 7.6 viewers, the 2013 Valero Alamo Bowl was the 7th most-watched non-BCS game in ESPN history.

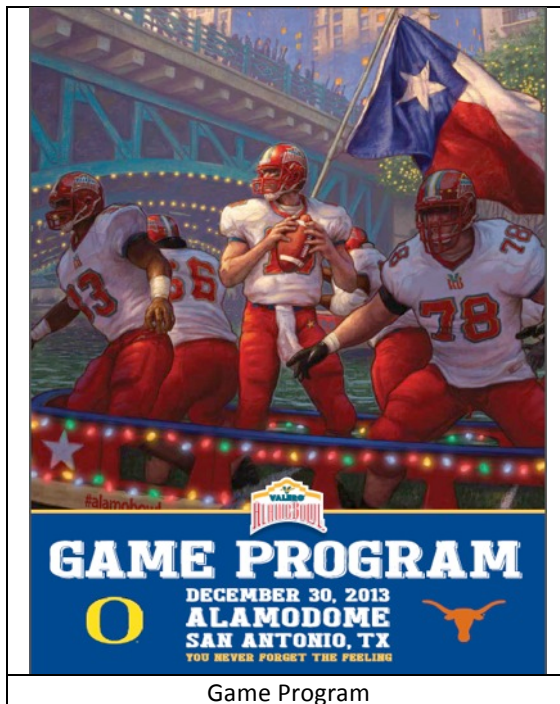
