


### **GAME DAY GUIDE**



### PEP RALLY







### GAME DAY PARKING & TRANSPORTATION



One of the easiest ways to get to the game is with VIA Park & Ride Service, which drops fans off at the Alamodome's north entrance. Service begins at 3:30 p.m. and will go through 12:30 a.m. so fans can watch the free Celebrate San Antonio fireworks show that ends at 12:15 a.m.

Round-trip fare is only \$5, and parking at VIA Park & Ride locations is free. Skip the line, download the goMobile app and pay for your fare from your smartphone!

If you are downtown, check out VIA's Primo bus service to the Alamodome that has several convenient stops. The Primo route is just \$1.30 each way. For more information on their Park & Ride and the Primo route, visit VIA online at **VIAinfo.net**.

Rideshare drop-off and pickup is at the Montana Street lot located at the base of the Alamodome's pedestrian bridge (Montana Street and Tower of Americas Way) behind the Convention Center.

Downtown San Antonio has over 30,000 parking spaces at a variety of parking lots where fans can park and get to the game. In general, Interstate 281/37 will be congested several hours prior to kickoff.

The exits to avoid off of 281/37 are Commerce and Cesar Chavez so plan other routes, knowing the largest number of surface lots exist to the north and northwest of the Alamodome.

Parking at the Alamodome is available through pre-purchased permits only. All on-site lots are at capacity and there will be no game day sales. If you don't have an Alamodome parking pass, do not try to exit near the facility.
